

NIKA ZUPANC was looking for an answer to a question that puzzled her: why is it that so many women throughout history have failed in fields where men have been so successful? The Slovenian designer eventually came to the conclusion that women don't focus as singlemindedly on their work as men do. So she sat down and designed an office furniture series entitled "Self-Discipline". The desk and chair both come with a golden crank handle that is used to adjust the height of the chair and, in the case of the desk, to reveal a series of document storage pockets. The design is simple and devoid of decoration - after all, the idea is that nothing should distract the user from her work.
