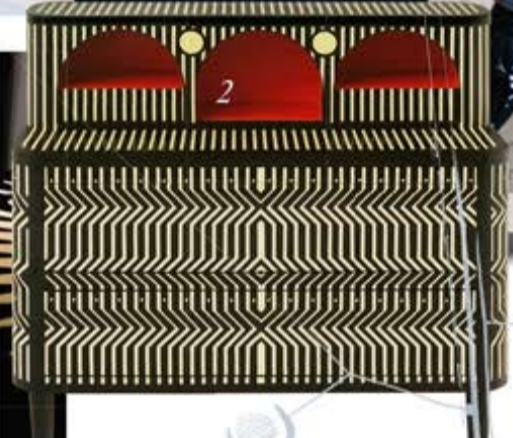

**NIKA ZUPANC** The Slovenian-born designer has been wowing visitors to Milan since her 2009 debut at Tortona. Her unique style incorporates high glamour with erotic overtones in a way that is luxurious and often highly dramatic. The designer's limited-edition work is sold through Milan design doyenne Rossana Orlandi, who launched Nika's 'Naked' desk during Salone with a special exhibition. Nika has other pieces in production with quirky Dutch brand Moooi and lighting brands Booo and Vertigo Bird and is slowly growing the eponymous label she debuted in 2005. This year she extended her Collection III range for British luxury brand Sé with eight new pieces and is working on a range of low-cost furniture and decorative pieces for Japanese brand Francfranc.
